Bondi Sands Pty Ltd, following consultation with the Therapeutic Goods Administration, is recalling batch 1104263, 1104264 and 1104743 of SPF 50+ Lotion Spray Coconut Beach (which is sunscreen that offers UVA and UVB protection) because benzene was detected in three batches of the product supplied in Australia. No other batches of SPF 50+ Lotion Spray Coconut Beach are affected by this recall.

If you have a bottle of SPF 50+ Lotion Spray Coconut Beach from batch 1104263, 1104264 and 1104743, do not use it. Return it to the place of purchase for a refund or call our customer service line to arrange the return of affected product and refund.

Benzene is not an ingredient in sunscreens but is suspected to be a contaminant from raw materials used in the product manufacture. The levels of benzene must be below 2 parts per million (ppm) in sunscreen products that are regulated as listed medicines in Australia. Benzene was detected at 2.2 ppm in one batch of the above product supplied in Australia.

Exposure to benzene in these sunscreen products, at the levels detected, would not be expected to cause serious adverse health effects. However, to reduce the risk to consumers, **Bondi Sands is recalling the batches of the affected products supplied within Australia.**
